CULTURE UNBOUND: JOURNAL OF CURRENT CULTURAL RESEARCH will be launched in 2009 as a new academic journal for border-crossing cultural research, including cultural studies as well as other interdisciplinary and transnational currents. It is globally open to articles from all areas in this large field, easily accessible for downloading as open access, and a forum with a wider scope than existing journals for cultural studies or other, more specific subfields of cultural research.

CULTURE UNBOUND is based at three vigorous Linköping University units that provide a unique Swedish profile, building new bridges between regional and global research traditions:

- The Advanced Cultural Studies Institute of Sweden (ACSIS), with interdisciplinary transnational exchange.
- The Department of Culture Studies (Tema Q), with interdisciplinary research and PhD education.
- The Swedish Cultural Policy Research Observatory (SweCult), interface for cultural research and the cultural sector.

Culture Unbound is an open access, peer-reviewed academic journal, published by Linköping University Electronic Press. Initial support has been granted by the Bank of Sweden Tercentenary Foundation (Stiftelsen Riksbankens Jubileumsfond) and by Linköping University's Faculty of Arts and Sciences. The editors welcome proposals for articles, reviews and thematic topics.
